J. P. True Memorial Scholarship

The J. P. True Memorial Scholarship Fund was established by his family in 1992.

There will be two scholarships awarded each year to students who attend an accredited college, university or vocational school. Although preference will be given to students who plan to major in agriculture, other applicants will be given due consideration. One scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from either Yuma High School or Liberty High School and one scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from either Wray High School or Idalia High School.

Each is a one-year scholarship. Each scholarship will be in the amount of at least \$1000.00

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the following:

- 1. Student must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.750 for six semesters.
- 2. Student must plan to major in agriculture.
- 3. Student must show financial need.
- 4. Student will write a one-page paper discussing his/her goals.
- 5. Student must provide a brief financial statement.
- 6. Student must have three letters of recommendation:
 - a.If you are an ag major, one letter from an Agriculture Education Instructor or
 - 4-H Agriculture Leader. If not an ag major, one letter from an educator in your school.
 - b.Two letters from persons other than school personnel.

The scholarship selection committee will consist of:

- 1. One family member.
- 2. Two other individuals chosen by the family.

Guidelines for Applicants

Scholarship forms are to be completed by the applicant and returned to the Scholarship Committee.

A completed application must contain the following in the order designated:

Application Form (To be completed by the student.)

Official transcript of high school courses and grades including the grade point average, rank, and size of graduating class, and ACT scores (or other comparable test scores.)

A paper, not to exceed one page, discussing your future plans and goals.

Student must have three letters of recommendation:

a.If you are an ag major, one letter from an Agriculture Education Instructor or

4-H Agriculture Leader. If not an ag major, one letter from an educator in your school.

b.Two letters from persons other than school personnel.

Three letters of recommendation:

One from an Agriculture Education instructor or 4-H Agriculture Leader.

Two from other than school personnel.
