This will be an adventure called TRAINcation with lessons provided daily in the following "soft skills" of the workplace; attitude, attendance, appearance, ambition, accountability, acceptance and appreciation. These are skills we take for granted and do not realize the importance of stressing. Your student is learning these qualities at home and in school and it is imperative that supporting your role and the school is done to impact your student's success in the workplace.

As part of becoming work-ready, please allow your student to become **registered in <u>www.ConnectingColorado.com</u>** before/during TRAINcation. This is a secured work search resource through the State of Colorado and the student will need to know their social security number <u>OR</u> if your home has the internet, please take a few moments and assist your child with this resource opportunity. *Please note that this information will not be used in any commercial or educational purposes.

After spending about an hour and a half in a classroom environment with activities, breakfast, and a snack will be provided with bottled water available throughout the day. With parental permission submitted and on record, your student will be transported to a local manufacturer's site for a tour and lunch. The business owner or a representative will speak to the students regarding, their journey, educational pursuits, and career opportunities and answer any questions the tour produces. After the tour and lunch, the students will return to the classroom to wrap up the day and prepare to return home about 1:00pm.
