TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT PLAN SPECIFICS:

Starting in 5th grade, students will be assigned a new Chromebook that they will keep through their 8th grade year. Upon entry to 9th grade, students will be given a new Chromebook to keep through their 12th grade year.

Chromebooks: All District-issued Chromebooks **require** parents and students to agree to the Technology Use Agreement, which will include a clause for any damage caused to the Chromebook while at home.

Charges:

\$250 - Replacement Chromebook

\$75 - Broken Screen

\$40 - Lost or Missing Chromebook Charger

\$40 - Keyboard Replacement

\$15 - Damage to Frame Around Screen

TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT EXPECTATIONS (CHROMEBOOKS)

1. The student and parent/guardian - You are responsible for taking care and maintaining your Chromebook. If there are issues with the device or it has been lost or stolen, please contact the districts' IT Director at clarksonb@yumaschools.net
2. Students/Parents must understand that Chromebooks and Internet platforms (email, Google Classroom, etc.) are school property and all contents (app data, Internet use and network use) will be monitored by the IT Director. There is no expectation of privacy and spot checks of Internet history, documents, email will be performed routinely.
3. If you are using your Chromebook for non-school related activities, the Chromebook may be subject to removal from your possession. All of your activity on the Chromebook is tracked. Everything must be school appropriate.
4. You may only use the applications that are already on the Chromebook, please do not download any other apps that are not approved by your school. If apps are discovered to be added, your Chromebook may be subject to removal or disabled.
5. A yumastudents.org email will be provided to all K-12 students. This email is to be used for all school related communications and to login to the Chromebook.
6. Each student is responsible for keeping track of the Chromebook and taking precautions to keep it safe.
7. Chromebooks must remain free of any writing, drawing, stickers or labels that are not the property or YSD-1. Stickers and barcodes applied by the district may not be removed or altered.
8. There may be a fee required for the loss or damage of a Chromebook that goes beyond normal use.
9. Chromebooks must be returned when requested by YSD-1.
