## Pat Mowry Post 96 American Legion and Auxiliary Scholarship

- 1. Purpose: to further the application's education at a college, university, or vocational school of their choice.
- 2. A committee of three to five qualified people shall be appointed by the Post who will serve as judges.
- 3. Each applicant shall submit a personal letter of application, three (3) letters of recommendation for this scholarship, one from the principal of the high school from which they have or are graduating; one from each of two (2) representative citizens of their community, as to the applicant's character, Americanism, leadership, and basis of need.
- 4. Candidates shall be selected on the following basis:
  - Character: High standards of conduct, keen sense of right, strength of character, adherence to truth, and conscience, devotion to church and daily duties.
  - Americanism: Fine ideals, love of country, ability to accept citizen responsibility.
  - Leadership: Ability to lead and accomplish through group activities, personal magnetism, guidance and thought of others.
  - Scholarship and actual need of financial assistance to continue higher education.
- 5. To be furnished by applicant:
  - Name and address
  - Photograph
  - Three letters as requested as above
  - Original article by application, about 200 words, on topic of applicant's choice
  - Any additional data attesting to qualifications, extra- curricular activities, civic participation, health, work experience, Academic Honors: etc.
  - Transcript
- 6. If applicant is selected by the committee, one- half (50%) of the scholarship will be given paid at the time of the entrance, the remaining one- half (50%) of the scholarship will be paid at the time a satisfactory transcript is furnished before 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of semester. The selected applicant must use the scholarship for the school year immediately following the year of graduation from high school.

7.	Eligibility: Applicant has to be a student in good standing in his or her class, a "C" average or better.
8.	This scholarship of \$600 will be offered annually by the American Legion Post 96 and the Auxiliary of Yuma, Colorado
