## A COMPLETE APPLICATION FOR YUMA COMMUNTIY FOUNDATION MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Transcript of high school courses and grades including grade point average, rank, size of graduation class and ACT score or other comparable score.
- 2. A paper in your own handwriting that tells your story and future plans. This is not to be longer than 8 ½ by 11 sheet of paper.
- 3. Two letters of recommendation:
  - a. One from school faculty
  - b. One from other than school faculty
- 4. Attach an official letter of acceptance from school you plan to attend.

The original and 4 copies of the entire application are due by April 11, 2025 to school counsellor.

With one application you have applied for all scholarships awarded by YCF.

#### JIM AND MILLIE VINCENT SCHOLARSHIP
