Money will be sent to the student's school of choice at the beginning of each session (1/3 each quarter, or 1/2 each semester) <u>upon receipt of evidence of at least part-time</u> <u>enrollment and of a "C" average for the prior session</u>. A copy of grade cards sent to the YCFCE Treasurer.

The scholarship will be awarded based on evidence presented in the application. The selection committee will look for evidence of the following:

1. Academic achievement.

2. Community and personal achievement as stated in your application and from your references.

3. Sincerity and interest in the field of Family and Consumer Studies (which includes most area of study) and should be evident in your statement of future goals and past achievements.

Guidelines for application:

1. Scholarship forms are to be completed by applicant and submitted to the Scholarship Chairman listed below.

2. Applications must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2025.

3. A complete application should contain the following:

a. Application form completed by the student,

b. Transcript of high school or college

c. Two letters of recommendation; one from school personnel and one from the community,

d. Current picture, no larger than 5" x7". This will be returned to you unless you are the scholarship recipient or alternate.
