10.0 SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Mr. Stannard talked about working sessions with one occurring since the February board meeting. Topics at the work session included discussion of Capital/High Expense Projects for 2012/13 including the high school pit floor, chairs in the gym needing fixed or replaced and the visitors bleachers at the football field needing replaced. Curriculum, ELL and Program changes proposed for the coming year and Recap and Update on proposed Personnel Actions/Organizational Chart Changes. Another working session will be scheduled for mid April to discuss the 1st full draft of the 2012/13 budget, Review & Discussion of Projects for the coming year and Review of District Improvement initiatives. Mr. Stannard said that we are planning a joint board session with the Sterling school board and CASB sometime in April or May.

Current items of interest noted by Mr. Stannard included TCAP (CSAP's) underway in the district with the third grade reading already done. RTTT, "Race To The Top" Mr. Stannard reported that the state of work is due this week. U.I.P. "Unified Improvement Plan" is due March 30th. We continue to work on Technology, bandwidth and performance.

Offers are being sent to returning teachers this week. The K-8 Leadership Team is in place for 2012-13 with some really great personnel to cover that building. The Matrix (draft #1) for SB 191 will be out this week which included 7 teachers and the superintendent working on this draft which will help measure teachers by levels and type of teacher. Since K-2 doesn't do CSAP the group is trying to propose some type of responsibility from the 2nd grade teachers as well.

SRP (School Response Protocol) Team will continue to meet working towards a September community drill where there will be no use of cell phones. The ELL/Woodcock-Munoz Model School candidacy is still pending and the Leadership team will be working on this during the summer. CDE will be coming for an ELL Project Quality Audit in late April or early May. Graduation for the Class of '12 is just over 9 weeks away!

11.0 BOARD REPORT/COMMENTS

It was reported that a community member was happy with our bus program and aide for special needs child being taken care of. There was a question of a pay increase for school personnel for the 2012/13 school year which was noted by Mr. Stannard to be a true statement. It was reported that YMS had 3 students attend the Spelling Bee in Denver at the Convention Center those students were Brandon Hinkle, Tara Hickman and Brittany Ross.
